



### Rwanda Update



One of the highlights of our trip was a 2-day coaching clinic where we conducted skills training as well as a full-sided tactical game. We had 24 coaches participate with 1 coach walking 4 hours round-trip to be there! We were able to share the Gospel with the coaches, and ended the clinic by presenting a soccer ball, SQ T-shirt, certificate of course completion, and Zeb's Foundation tote bag to each participant.



Sports Quest was given the opportunity to share the Gospel through the illustration of soccer at a youth conference to approximately 100 youth, ages 14-35. We were also given the opportunity to gift soccer balls from Zeb's Foundation to officials at a nationally-televised soccer Cup Final, and share the Gospel through Zeb's story with the 2,500 in attendance.



We were able to participate in a 5K called "Run with Rwanda." This 5K was simulcast with an identical run in Colorado, and was for the purpose of promoting unity and reconciliation in Rwanda. The entire race was uphill in the mud, so we got our exercise in!
